Daniel Newman

Mr. Daniel Newman is a Partner in the Miami office of Broad and Cassel. He is a member of the Firm's Commercial Litigation Practice Group.

■ Mr. Newman specializes in complex commercial, securities and construction litigation in state and federal courts and in arbitrations.

■ He holds an AV rating with Martindale-Hubbell, a rating achieved by only 5 percent of attorneys. He has also been designated a "Florida Super Lawyer" by *Law & Politics* magazine in 2006, 2007 and 2009 and a "Florida Legal Elite" in *Florida Trend* Magazine by his peers in 2008 and 2009.

■ Mr. Newman recently obtained preliminary injunctive relief for a client in a state court proceeding where the client was induced to invest in a fraudulent investment opportunity. He also recently obtained temporary and preliminary injunctive relief for a technology company in federal court against a competitor of the client, prohibiting that company from disclosing the client's confidential and proprietary information in accordance with a pre-existing contract.

■ Mr. Newman has worked on many other notable cases, including representing a CFO in one of the first Sarbanes-Oxley officer certification cases prosecuted by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), and the defense of the City of Miami in an SEC proceeding that alleged securities fraud in connection with three of the City's municipal bond offerings. Along with another partner, he successfully defended one of the country's largest broker-dealers in a defamation action brought by a former broker.

■ Mr. Newman has served as counsel to Receivers in both SEC and Federal Trade Commission (FTC) Proceedings and currently serves as a Receiver in connection with actions instituted by the SEC. He also represents clients before the SEC in enforcement proceedings and represents securities broker-dealers and brokers in FINRA and state regulatory proceedings. Further, he represents securities broker-dealers and brokers in securities arbitrations.

■ Mr. Newman served as an attorney in the Division of Enforcement of the SEC's Northeast Regional Office, where his responsibilities included investigation and civil prosecution of violations of the federal securities laws.

He serves as an Executive Board Member of a local organization and coaches soccer and ice hockey in local youth leagues.
